The awards support any applicants who plan to attend a vocational program at a Technical/Vocational School or Community College for any vocational associate's degree or career/technical certification program. The Rotary Club also awards an Academic scholarship, the applicant cannot apply for both.

Selection Criteria: Graduating high school senior during the 2020-21 school year.  
Scholastic standing considered.  
Financial need.  
School involvement and honors.  
Community involvement.

Required Documents to be included in order to be eligible:

- Completed application.
- Official Transcript from your high school.
- Letters of recommendation from each reference below:
  - o An administrator or counselor
  - o Someone not related to you who knows you personally
  - o A teacher
- Your personal essay. Tell us about yourself, why you want to continue your education, your career goals, and how receiving this scholarship will impact your future ambitions. The essay should not be more than 250 words.

Award Details: Up to \$4,000, paid over a time period of 4 years at \$500 per semester upon meeting the Scholarship Committee's Award Requirements, detailed in a post selection award letter.

Deadline: March 31, 2021 (**All required documents listed above must be submitted by the deadline**)
